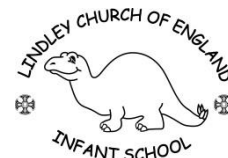

Sport Premium Allocation 2015-16



What is the Sports Premium?

The government is providing funding of to provide new and substantial primary school sport funding. The funding is being jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport, and will see money going directly to primary school Headteachers to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for children in KS1 and older. The money can only be spent on sport and PE provision in schools. Schools will have to spend the sport funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this. In this way, our children will gain new skills and experiences and teachers will learn new techniques and knowledge to aid them in teaching sport and PE.

The long term aim is higher quality lessons and improved learning for all children.
